

Is your home hard to heat?

If you live in a private rented property, your landlord must make sure your home is not unreasonably hard to heat. It is unlawful for landlords to let out a property with an Energy Performance Certificate rated F or G (in properties where an EPC is legally required). We can also advise landlords on grants available to help meet the cost of making improvements.
