Email from resident regarding enquiries as to the ownership of the defibrillator:

It has been brought to my attention that at the recent Parish Council meeting there was a query regarding the ownership of the defibrillator at Barton Bendish Village Hall.

In November 2014 I personally paid for it and at a later date it was adopted by the Parish Council. As far as I'm concerned it is now in the ownership of the Parish Council although I continue to regularly check that is working properly. If there is a problem I report it to Parish Councillor Dr Tim Webster as well as passing on to him any communications I receive from WEL Medical Ltd, the company who installed it.
